- Please make sure that the names, affiliations, and countries of all contributing authors are included during the submission process. Incomplete author information may lead to the manuscript being returned or contributors being omitted from the final publication.
- Submissions must be made by one of the authors listed on the manuscript. We kindly ask that the submission is not be completed on behalf of someone else. The submitting author will take responsibility for the manuscript during the submission and review process.
- We remind authors once again to ensure all contributing authors' information (names, affiliations, countries) is provided accurately during the submission process.

- Kindly number all references consecutively using square brackets, in the order they appear in the text (including tables or legends). Use *Times New Roman*, font size 11. Each reference should have its unique number. Please avoid excessive referencing. If using an automatic numbering system, ensure it is finalized and fully formatted before submission.
- Please cite only articles and abstracts that are published, in press, or available on public e-print/preprint servers. Unpublished abstracts, data, or personal communications should not appear in the reference list, though they may be mentioned in the text if necessary. Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to cite personal communications and unpublished material. All named authors should be listed in citations, regardless of the number. Typically, submissions should not exceed 20 references unless the manuscript is a review paper.
