 - ✓ References are NOT allowed.
- Introduction
 - \checkmark Outline the purpose of doing the research and objective of research.
- Materials and Methods
 - \checkmark Ethics/Permission to conduct the study.
 - ✓ Study Design/Study Setting/Study population.
- Results
 - ✓ State important findings first.
 - ✓ **One table**; self-explanatory and brief title.
 - ✓ One figure; self-explanatory and brief legend; JPEG format (if no figure two tables are allowed).
 - \checkmark Avoid duplication of results in tables and figures or in text.
- Discussion
 - ✓ Summary of key findings.
 - ✓ Strengths and limitations of study.
 - ✓ Interpretation with previous published research.
- Conclusion
 - ✓ Objectives need to be addressed.
 - ✓ Implication and significance for professional practice.
 - ✓ Future research directions.

- ✓ Numbered consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text (not in alphabetic order).
- ✓ Identify references in text, tables, and legends by Arabic numerals in square bracket after the punctuation marks.
- ✓ Maximum **20 references** allowed.
