The Scientific Committee for the 17th International Postgraduate Colloquium (IPRC 2020) invites you to submit your research abstracts. Abstracts are sought for voice-narrated slides presentations. Submission of abstracts may be done individually or by groups.

ABSTRACT REQUIREMENT

IPRC Abstract Must be Formatted as Follows:

- On the first line, write the heading "Abstract" (centered and without any formatting)
- Do not indent any part of the text
- Single space the text
- Use Times New Roman font in 12 pt
- Set one-inch (or 2.54 cm) margins
- If you include a "keywords" section at the end of the abstract, indent the first line and italicize the word "Keywords" while leaving the keywords themselves without any formatting

The Common Content of an Abstract

Simply put together the answers to the following questions.

- What is the problem? Outline the <u>objective</u>, <u>research questions</u> and/or <u>hypotheses</u>.
- What has been done? Explain your research methods.
- What did you discover? Summarize the key findings and conclusions.
- What do the findings mean? Summarize the <u>discussion</u> and <u>recommendations</u>.
