



International Research and Innovation Day (IRID) IIUM 2025 Guidelines for Recorded E-Poster Presentations (International Participants Only)

1. Recording Requirements

- Presentation duration: Maximum of 5 minutes.
- Language: Both the presentation and the e-poster must be in English.

2. Video Upload and File Submission

All presenters are required to upload their recorded presentation to YouTube and submit the video link via the designated Google Form. Please follow the steps below:

- Prepare and record your e-poster presentation video.
- Upload the video to your YouTube account.
- During the upload process, set the Video Visibility to "Unlisted." Unlisted videos can only be viewed by individuals who have the link and will not appear publicly on your YouTube channel.
- Once the upload is complete, copy the unlisted YouTube link.
- Paste the link into the Google Form:

- Ensure the video remains accessible (unlisted, not private) until the conference has concluded.

3. Question and Answer Session

- All presenters must be prepared to respond to questions during the designated Q&A session, as indicated in the tentative programme.

4. Submission Deadline

- Recorded e-poster presentations must be submitted no later than **10 June 2026, by 5.00 PM (Malaysian local time)**.
- Late submissions may not be accepted.

5. Submission Compliance

- Please ensure that all required information is completed accurately and matches the accepted abstract.
- The Organising Committee will not be responsible for any errors in the presentation, which may be subject to penalties by the judges.
